

URGENT MESSAGE
HIGHEST PRIORITY!

TO: The Scouts of Pack 311
FROM: Lord Baden-Powell

Dear Scouts,

I have an urgent matter of utmost importance and I need your help. The "Golden Warrior and the Arrow of Light" idol, a symbol of high achievement amongst ancient native peoples and a valuable artifact to the Scouting community, was stolen last year from the National Scouting Museum in Irving, Texas. Please find a postcard of the idol enclosed.

I immediately sent my good friend Dr. Indiana Jones on the quest to retrieve the Golden Warrior, for it was he who first discovered the artifact and brought it to the museum when he was a young Boy Scout. There are photos of Indy also enclosed for your reference.

In the last telegram I received, he told me that the idol was almost within his grasp. But that was nearly a month ago, and I haven't heard from him since. I fear my good friend has disappeared! You must help me find Indiana Jones!

Contained in the package that was parachuted to your camp this morning are all the materials you will need to follow in his footsteps and hopefully find Dr. Jones. First, I will need you to organize four search parties.

In one of the four color-coded team packages you will each find a passport book with your name printed inside it, but since you may need to assume the identity of Dr. Jones in order to track him, the picture on the passport is Indy's. When entering a new country, make sure you get your passport booklet stamped so that I know where you have been.

You will also find a colored kerchief in your team's package. Please put it on immediately! Your kerchief will identify you as a member of either the GREEN team, BLACK team, YELLOW team, or RED team.

In your team's package, please also find a map that will lead you to your first destination on the trail of Indiana Jones. After that, it's all up to you. Keep your eyes and ears open. Look for clues. Work together. Be prepared.
